One's name inscribed on the golden roll

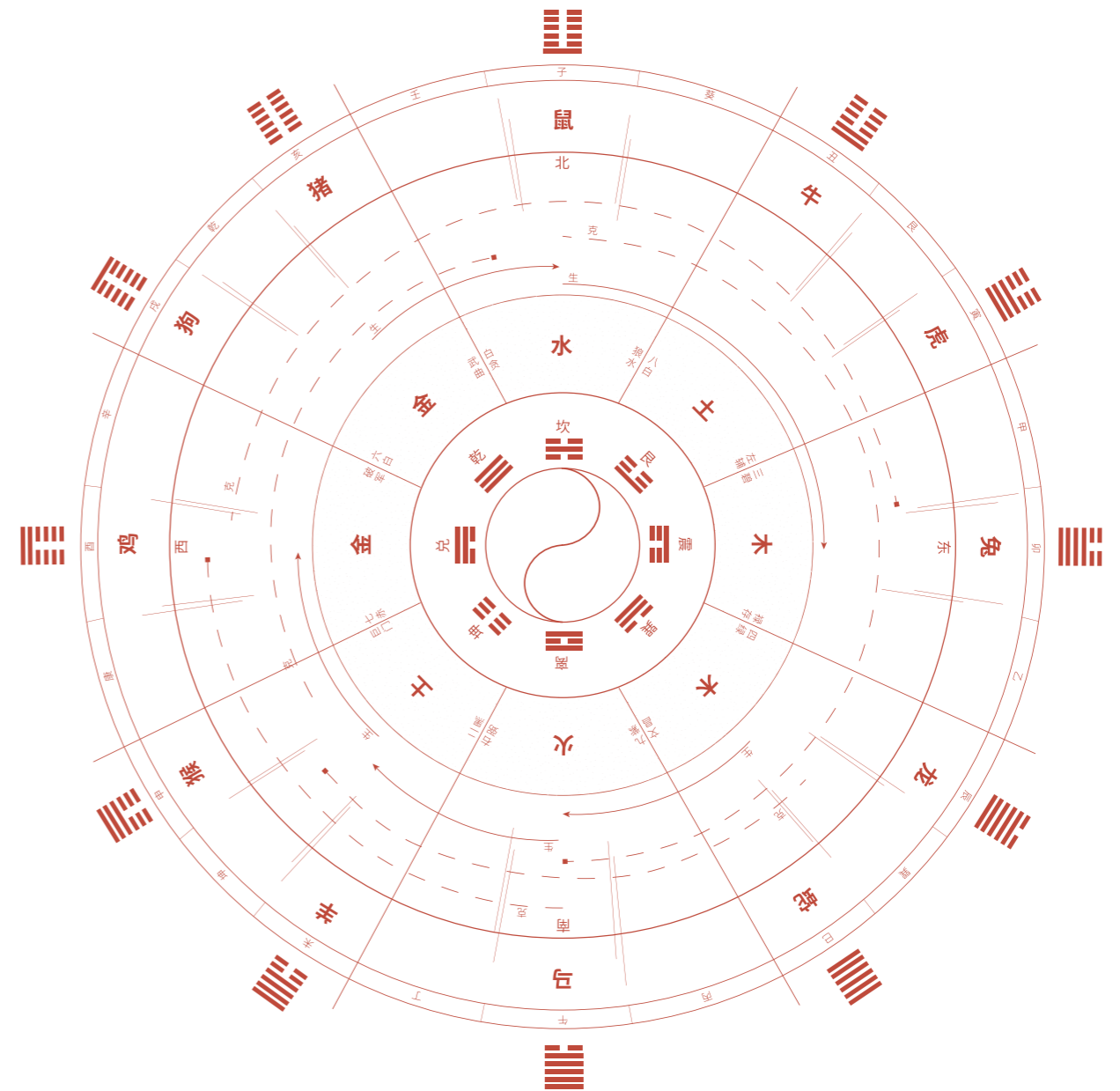


Among these joys, the bliss of the wedding night—lit by crimson candles—is deeply intertwined with familial bonds. In traditional Chinese culture, marriage is not merely a union of two individuals, but a convergence of two families. It demands careful consideration of factors, such as family background, social status, economic standing, and personal character. Both the couple's shared history and their projected future are deemed critical. Additionally, assessing whether their Bazi (birth charts) align harmoniously—complementing strengths and offsetting weaknesses—requires the expertise of a traditional fortune-teller, who interprets the cosmic patterns governing their fates.

Interactions of the Five Elements, Heavenly Stems, and Earthly Branches: Mutual Generation and Restraint
Five Elements Compatibility in Marriage Bazi (Birth Chart) Compatibility in Marriage

Using the structure of the traditional Bagua (Eight Trigrams) formation, this diagram interprets the Five Elements attributes associated with each trigram from the *I Ching (Book of Changes)* and the *San Ming Tong Hui (Compendium of Three Fates)*. It maps their correlations to the twelve Earthly Branches (traditional Chinese time periods) and annotates their corresponding relationships of mutual generation and restraint. These cyclical interactions are closely tied to hexagrams governing marriage compatibility, reflecting the deep interplay between elemental dynamics and marital harmony in traditional divination.



Marriage Compatibility Analysis |

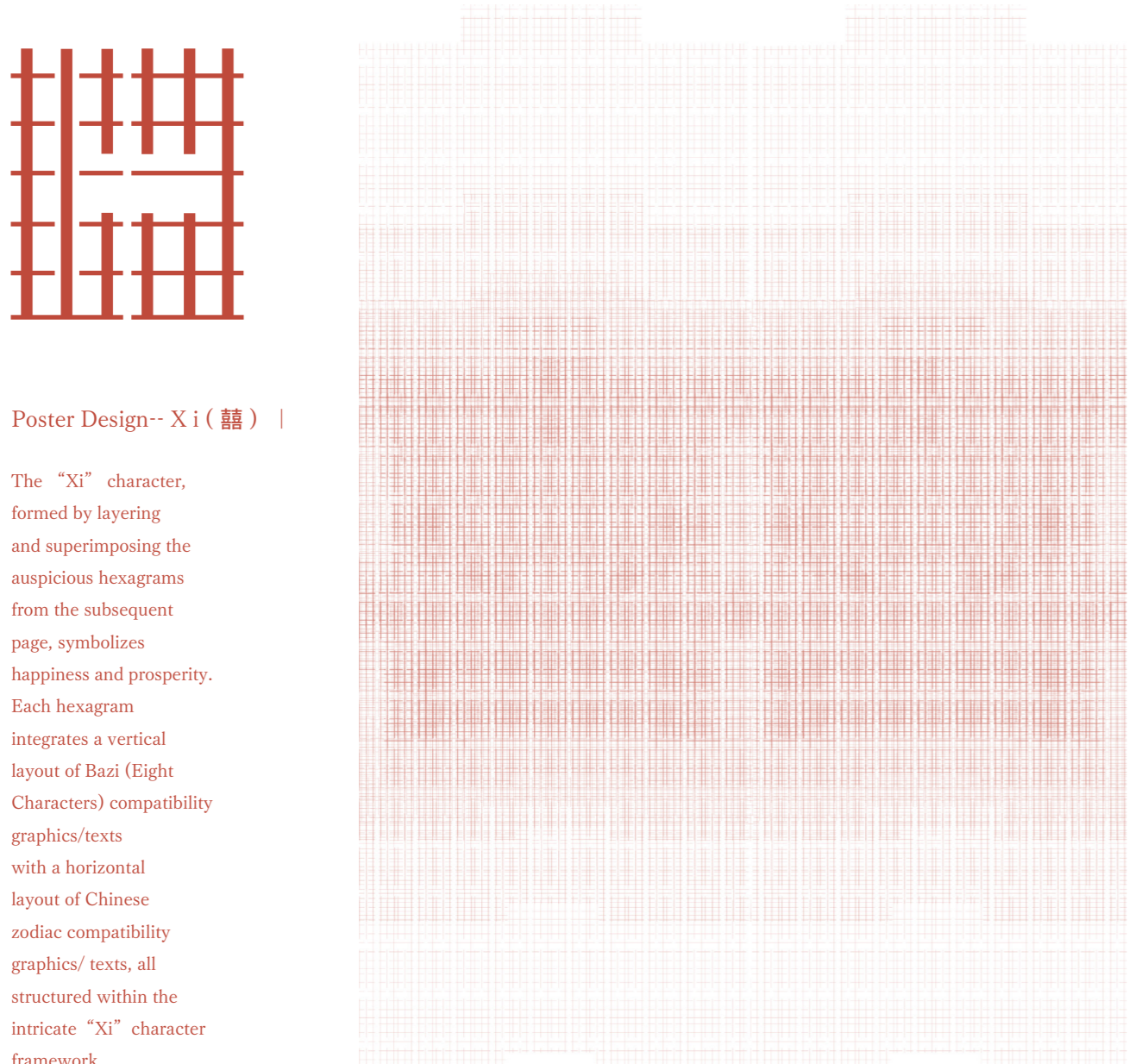

The “Xi” character, formed by layering and superimposing the auspicious hexagrams from the subsequent page, symbolizes happiness and prosperity. Each hexagram integrates a vertical layout of Bazi (Eight Characters) compatibility graphics/texts with a horizontal layout of Chinese zodiac compatibility graphics/ texts, all structured within the intricate “Xi” character framework.

Marriage Compatibility Bazi (Birth Chart) Table

- Rat: Dragon, Monkey, Ox (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Ox: Rat, Snake, Rooster (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Tiger: Horse, Dog, Pig (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Rabbit: Goat, Dog, Pig (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Dragon: Rat, Monkey, Rooster (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Snake: Ox, Rooster (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Horse: Goat, Tiger, Dog (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Goat: Rabbit, Horse, Pig (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Monkey: Rat, Snake, Dragon, Dog (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Rooster: Ox, Dragon, Snake (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Dog: Tiger, Rabbit, Horse (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
- Pig: Goat, Rabbit, Tiger (most auspicious); other signs are less compatible.
